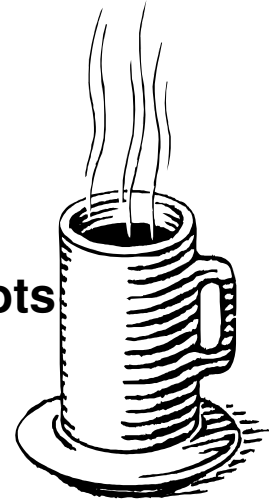


Poetry and Music at Tim Hortons
